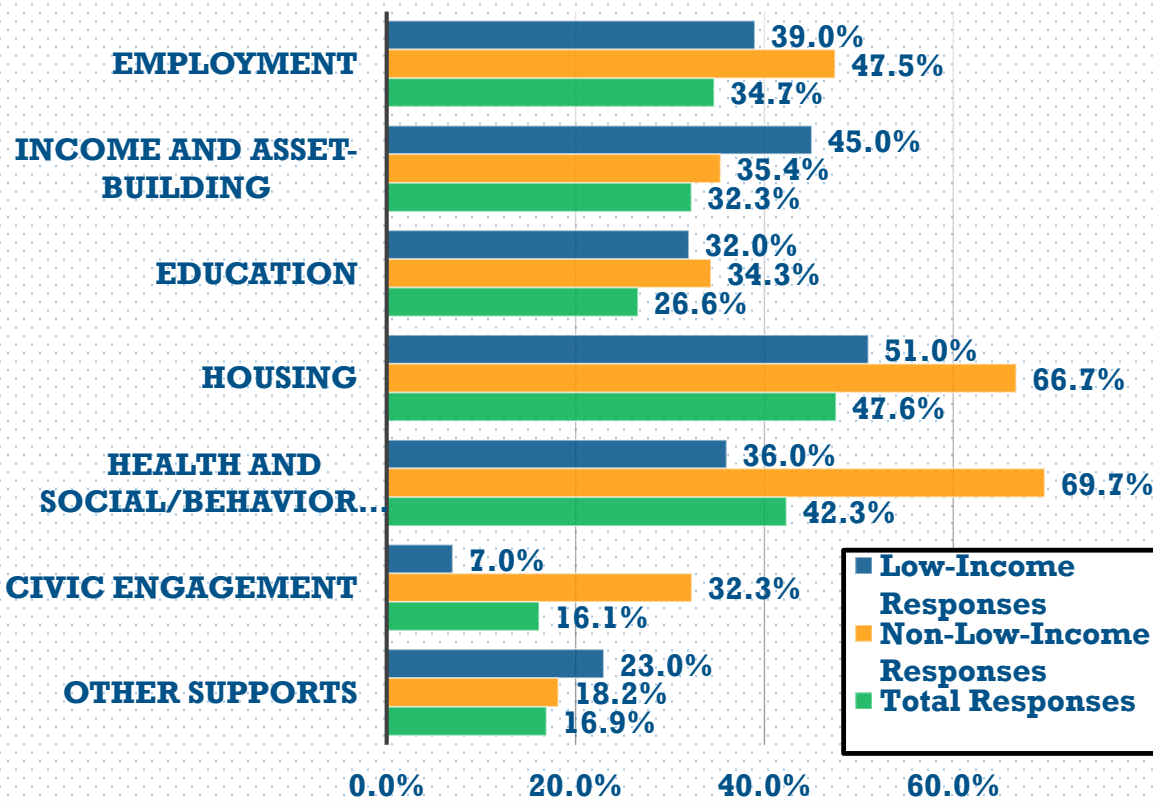

Overall Community (Low-Income & Non-Low-Income)

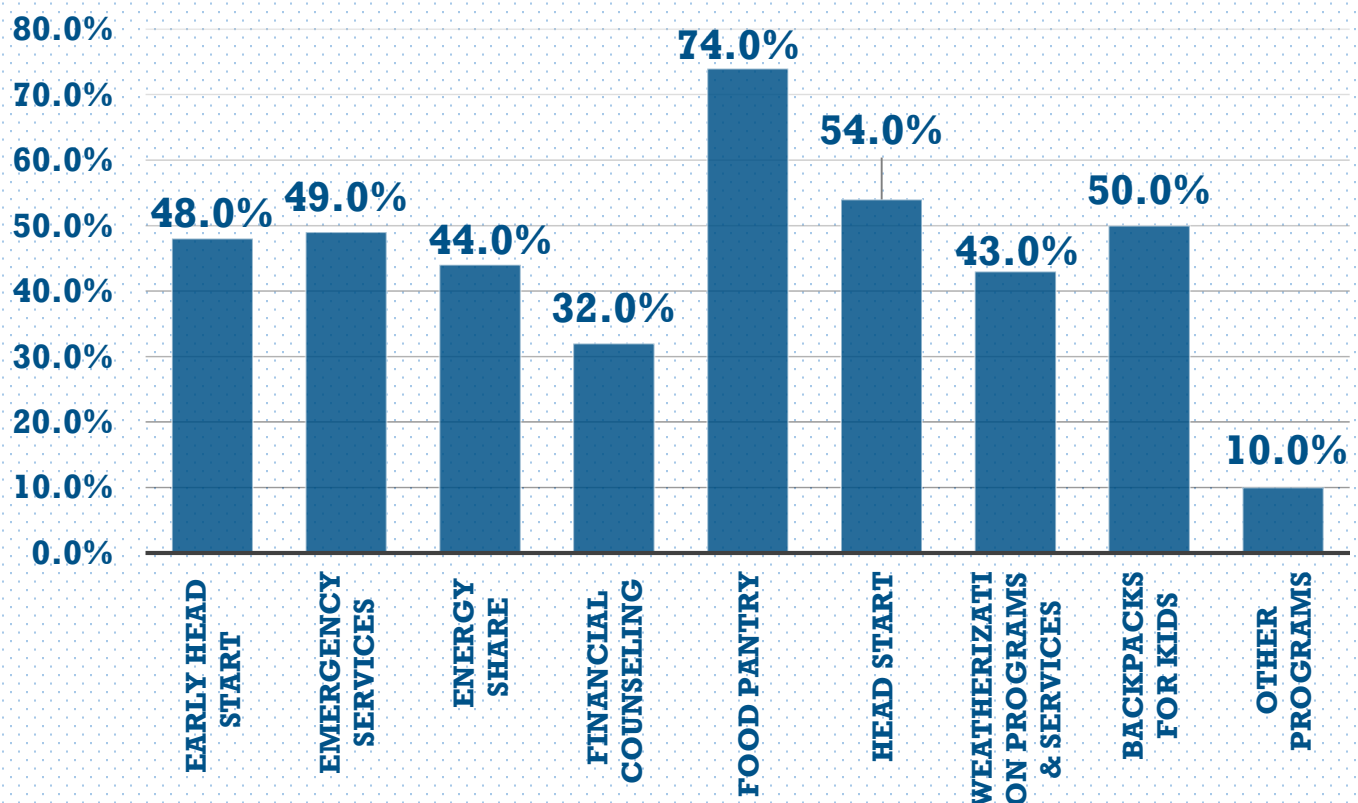
